Identifies what is compared/contrasted?

Is each sentence relevant to your thesis? Is text support linked explicitly to the MSP? (Don't drift away from your MSP!)

Content: ALL TARGETS MET

Engaging title?

Expanded, engaging introduction?

- Hook? Does intro identify plays and author before the thesis?
- Background information?

Each MSP supports the thesis? Is focused?

Each MSP is supported by relevant proof from books & analysis

- All statements about plays are supported with cited examples (2 examples are better than 1.)
- All quotes and examples are explained so that the reader understands how they prove what you
 say that they prove
- All statements are relevant to the thesis and MSP of paragraph
- Arguments + proof reflect good grasp of texts/ convincing and persuasive argument s + proof
- Reasoning is clear, logical & with full development
- One quote per paragraph that develops a key point
- Quotes are woven in with foundation + significance

All statements about book are accurate

No unnecessary repeats of ideas/ no overlaps

Conclusion ties all MSPs together to arrive at significant insight

Organization: ALL TARGETS MET

Introduction funnels down smoothly to thesis/ no gaps

Each body paragraph has one MSP identified in topic sentence Each topic sent. has explicit link to thesis + *covers* body paragraph

Topic sentences are 1st or 2nd sentence in paragraph

Logical order of ideas

Body paragraphs have smooth closure sentence

Uses appropriate transition words between and within paragraphs

Smooth conclusion – echoes thesis and answers "so what?"

Style: ALL TARGETS MET

Clear / concise/ good word choice/ no wordiness

No 1st or 2nd person/ no slang/ no contractions

no faulty parallelism/ no awkward or stringy sentences

Edit & Format: ALL TARGETS MET / proofread/ neat appearance

Correct spelling, quote punctuation, commas, capitalization, usage, pronouns, title rules, clause punctuation, effective colon usage, possessives

No fragments or errors in sentence structure!

Appropriate verb tense

MLA format: numbers, heading, pagination, citations, quote format, double-spaced

Works Cited - attached + accurate
