Focus (0-10) – TARGETS CHECKED OFF + MET?

- **Does the essay contain a focused thesis statement that responds to the prompt?**
- □ Thesis statement is one sentence followed by preview of support
- Does every sentence in the essay relate to and support the thesis statement?
 - All topic sentences are linked explicitly to the thesis statement w/ key words (message/ main character)?
 - Ideas within body paragraphs are linked back to MSP and thesis with key words?
- □ Is the thesis echoed (but <u>not</u> repeated verbatim) in the conclusion?

Organization (0-10) -TARGETS CHECKED OFF + MET?

- □ Intro funnels down <u>smoothly</u> to thesis with no gaps/ thesis + POS appear at end of introduction
- □ Each body paragraph has one non-overlapping MSP identified in topic sentence that explicitly links to thesis and completely covers the paragraph
- \Box Topic sentences are 1st or 2nd sentence in paragraph
- □ Logical order to body paragraphs
- □ Logical order of ideas within body paragraph; ideas don't repeat or overlap
- □ Body paragraphs "wrap up" smoothly and with closure <u>+ LINK TO MESSAGE</u>
- Uses *appropriate* transition words to connect body paragraphs + ideas within body paragraphs
- □ Smooth conclusion/ not repetitious/ provides closure and "goes universal"

Content (0-10) - TARGETS CHECKED OFF + MET?

- □ Engaging title?
- □ Intro. paragraph is engaging, clear, relevant , + includes background and name of work and author.
- **D** The body paragraphs persuasively <u>prove</u> the assertion of the thesis.
- □ The assertion of each topic sentence is supported by <u>specific proof</u> from book & <u>analysis</u>.
- □ ALL statements about text are supported with <u>cited</u> examples or quotes (minimum = 2 per MSP.)
- □ All examples are explained AND LINKED TO THE RELEVANT POINT THEY ARE SUPPOSED TO PROVE.
- □ All statements are relevant to the thesis and MSP of paragraph.
- **□** Reasoning is logical & with **enough development** to be clear and persuasive.
- □ All statements about text are accurate.
- □ No unnecessary repeats of ideas/ overlaps/ contradictions.

Focus Skill: Quotes (0-10) - TARGETS CHECKED OFF + MET?

- **Quotes are chosen to highlight key points.**
- □ At least one quote per body paragraph
- □ Smoothly woven in with foundation + significance
- □ Punctuated and cited correctly

Style (0-10) - TARGETS CHECKED OFF + MET?

- □ Clear / precise word choice/ not wordy
- \Box No 1st or 2nd person/ no slang! / no contractions
- Good flow to sentences/ no missing words or awkward constructions/ no announcements

Editing (0-10) - TARGETS CHECKED OFF + MET?

- □ All rules covered in class are applied- CCWs, commas, possessives, clauses, pronouns, titles, caps
- □ No fragments, comma splices, run ons
- □ Appropriate & consistent verb tense- USE PRESENT TENSE TO SUMMARIZE LITERATURE
- □ Neatness/ proofread/ no weird spacing

Compliance with writing process/ format (0-10) - TARGETS CHECKED OFF + MET?

- □ MLA format: heading, date, pagination, title, in-text cites, spacing/ double spaced, numbers/ Work Cited page
- □ Directions followed –**in folder with old graded draft.** appropriate check-offs/ highlighting. *This rubric attached to top of draft*.
