Language and style: Read/ review the handout on epic style. What and where is the Invocation of the Muse? What is an epithet? Can you find one?
<b>Something to consider (This means I'll probably ask this on a test):</b> Books I- IV are sometimes referred to as the " <b>Telemachy,"</b> the story of Telemachus, son of Odysseus. What possible reasons would Homer have to begin with a focus on Telemachus, rather than on Odysseus himself?
Ancient Greek Customs to note:  ➤ gods (esp. Athena) turning into birds
➤ using a father's name + -ides as a type of nickname. (This is called a patronymic.)
So what would <u>your patronymic</u> be?
